

IX. PARTICIPANT PLANS THAT FAILED OR WERE ABANDONED

As to why some Participant plans failed or were abandoned, the reason is simple: Petitioner zigged when they expected a zag. For instance, the plan to kill Petitioner prior to the Court Shun and frame the CI fell apart because Petitioner did not meet and eat with the CI in San Diego. There were no teen, parent or CI "liars" testimony because Petitioner did not testify, thus no liars rebuttal. Additionally, the SD Sheriff Nurse med did not kill Petitioner because Petitioner did not eat the tainted food. Petitioner, intending only an act of kindness, provided most of the meals to an indigent inmate, Billy Greer, SD Sheriff Inmate #12512128, DOB 1/9/50. Billy was rushed to the hospital and never returned. Later, a private investigator, Bruce Timan, license #26714, was engaged to locate Billy (App 137). No written report was received. Also, Turner Family members were no longer expendable [SEN: ST CO TURNERS DIE, THUS JOHN MF TRIAL SAFE] because they were needed for a Talbot Co Court Shun [FEINSTEIN: RET MAR ST CO, JUST LOAD A FRESH SHUN].

The appearance, contents, substance, internal patterns and other distinctive characteristics of the intentional anagrams deciphered, exhibited and discussed herein, including information that persons other than Participants are not likely to possess, demonstrates that the intentional anagrams are covert communications by and between Participants. Furthermore, many statements are authenticated via the reply doctrine. Replies to communications are authenticated without more.

Petitioner has accurately deciphered Participant messages, but has no control over the accuracy of the sender's information therein.
